Oahu Ghost Tours takes guests to some of the most haunted locations in Hawaii as well as spots where significant history



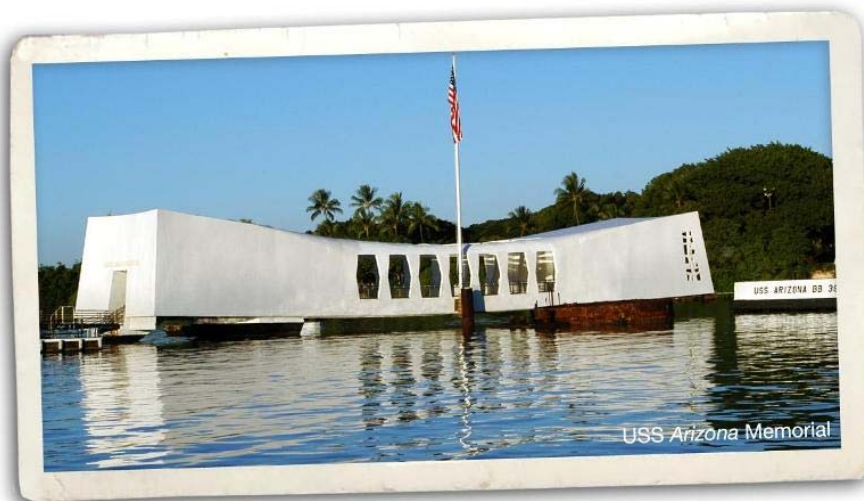
took place. We specialize in Hawaii's haunted and supernatural, both past and present. Our tours are not scripted or rehearsed and no two tours are alike.
